Camp Tel Yehudah, Young Judaea's national teen leadership camp, seeks Social Worker or Psychologist to join our leadership team this summer (Mid-June through Mid-August). Our Camp Social Worker or Psychologist spends the summer at camp providing guidance and support to our teenage campers and staff.

Essential Job Functions:

- Participate in and help lead pre-camp training
- Offer emotional support and guidance to individual campers
- Respond to concerns of parents
- Consult with staff about individual camper and group issues
- Work with staff on conflict resolution issues
- Work with staff to develop and implement programs on topics such as bullying and body image
- Work with camp medical staff to ensure and promote the health and wellness of all campers
- Participate in camp activities and be an involved member of the staff

Requirements:

- A Masters Degree in Social Work or Psychology with 2+ years practical experience with teenagers and/or families
- Demonstrated ability to work cooperatively as a team member
- Willingness to reside at camp for entire camp period
